You can also access the school website via the app and this will be important to keep up to date with events in the calendar.

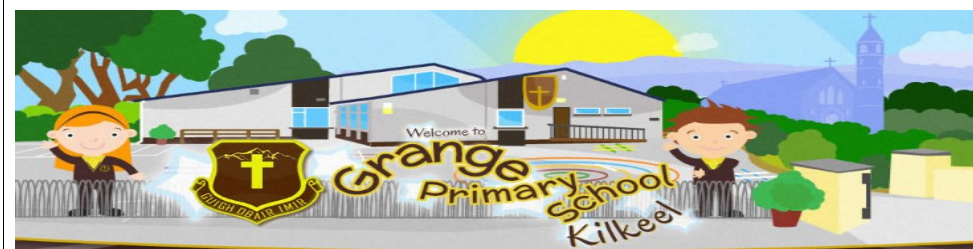
### Lost property
